These experiences shaped my approach as a "Workshopper" and Art Coach; an educator for everyone, especially those who would typically shy away from taking an art class.

My creative empowerment workshops are mobile, accessible, and designed to meet people where they are. I've taught in museums, libraries, art centers, and community spaces across New England—always with a focus on inclusion and encouragement. While many institutions offer art classes, few are designed for those who believe they "can't draw a stick figure." My sessions provide a supportive, step-by-step environment where everyone is guided to create with confidence.

It's a privilege to witness people move past their limiting beliefs and discover that there's no such thing as a "non-artist"—only artists with something in their way. In a world that so deeply needs compassion, creativity, and innovation, the arts hold the key to meaningful change.
